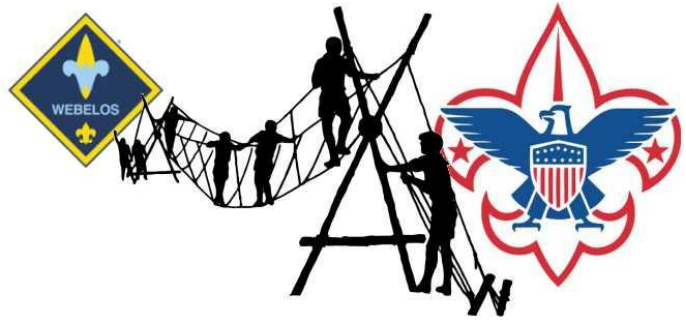


# WEBELOS WOODS 2017

May 19-21, 2017



**Boy Scout Adult and Youth Leaders:** Do you want to keep your Troop healthy with a good group of new Webelos Scouts joining your Troop in 2017? Your participation in Webelos Woods 2016 is critical to that goal. You will help introduce these Webelos to the Patrol Method of Scouting and excite them with your stories of the adventures that lie ahead for them in Boy Scouting with your Troop.

Webelos Woods is a proven program with a 40 year history of introducing Webelos Scouts and their parents to what Boy Scouting is about through a weekend of camping and activities. Fourth grade Webelos Scouts will camp as Patrols as they will in Boy Scouts. They will cook for themselves with Boy Scouts from their aligned Troops serving as their Patrol Leaders. Adult leaders from the Troop and the Webelos Den Leader will provide adult guidance. Webelos parents will tent and eat separately but near the Scouts. The Scouts will learn to work together as a team in their Patrol and will choose a Patrol name and create a Patrol flag.

As a result of this program, participants should come away with:

- An understanding of the Boy Scout program, the skills they will learn, and the fun that is possible.
- An appreciation of a Boy Scout Troop, how it is run, & how it differs from a Cub Scout Pack.
- An increased desire to continue Scouting as a Boy Scout in a Troop.
- An opportunity for Webelos Scouts, Webelos Leaders, and parents to meet Scouts and Scout leaders from the Troops their sons may join.

To make this happen, we need your help. We would like to have 2 adult leaders and two senior Boy Scout leaders to work with Webelos Scouts and parents from the Cub Scout Pack aligned with your Troop. The Boy Scout youth leaders will serve as Patrol Leader and Assistant for the Patrol of Webelos Scouts and help teach and guide them in how a Patrol works together in the usual camping activities: setting up camp, cooking, cleanup, creating a Patrol flag and participating in the weekend events – skill stations to introduce them to basic Scouting skills.

**Cost:** \$15 for participating Boy Scout youth and adults. They should register as staff members to get this rate. This includes food and an activity patch.
